

Steve Chabot on the Right to Life

“[Abortion] is violent, it’s gruesome, it’s horrific, it’s barbaric, it’s infanticide. It’s not about politics. It’s about protecting those innocent human lives... lives that have a right to be born. And to destroy them is murder, that’s what it amounts to. We need to protect these babies.” -Rep. Steve Chabot, House Floor, June 4, 2003

Steve’s Pro-Life Record is Clear

-  H.R. 358 – The Protect Life Act would amend the new health care reform law to ensure that federal funds are not supporting health plans that provide abortions.
-  H.J. Res. 43- would block Washington, D.C.’s Anti-Religious Freedom Law, which could force pro-life groups to hire employees who disagree with their mission and potentially pay for abortions in their health care plan.
-  H. Con. Res. 27- would eliminate funding for abortion providers and ensure that organizations are not forced to finance activities or health decisions that violate their religious or moral beliefs.
-  H.R. 816 – The Life At Conception Act would nullify the ruling in Roe v. Wade and declare that the Constitution guarantees the right to life begins at the moment of fertilization.
-  H.R. 7 – The No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act would prevent all federal funding of abortions.



“One of my proudest accomplishments during my time in Congress was when President Bush signed into law the Partial Birth Abortion Ban Act on November 3, 2003. Nearly four years later, in 2007, the U.S. Supreme Court constitutionally upheld this ban. This critical legislation, which I authored, put an end to a procedure that many have referred to as infanticide, and confirmed that this abhorrent practice has no place in society.”
